Project Checklist for April

- Visit garden center to check out all the new plants arriving!
- Fertilize your trees when new growth appears.
- Repair your lawn by raking, power-raking, aeration, or re-seeding if necessary. Pre-soak grass seeds for better germination. Mulch the bare spots to help insulate seeds.
- Apply slow release fertilizer with crabgrass pre-emergent after the forsythia bloom.
- Plant containers with pansies or seaside daisies that can tolerate the cooler temperatures.
- Leave spring bulb foliage in tack for 6 weeks or until it turns yellow.
- Seed cool weather crops such as lettuce, spinach, peas directly into soil. Plant asparagus roots and onion sets.
- Trim established herbs.
- Remulch beds as necessary.
- Begin weeding beds to keep ahead on them.
- Apply Preen, a pre-emergent weed preventer to beds.
- Remove tent caterpillars and webs.
- Preventative disease control on roses & fruit trees.
