Project Checklist for August

- Water your plants and annuals on regular basis when they show signs of wilting or burnt leaves. Give your annuals a shot of fertilizer.
- Inspect your trees, shrubs, and perennials regularly for pests.
- Inspect and treat roses for pests.
- Trim back your annuals early in the month to encourage new growth.
- Keep an eye on your pond or water feature for algae growth.
- Gather herbs and flowers for drying.
- Dead-head perennials and annuals.
- Begin cuttings of new plants.
- Plant cool weather crops such as lettuce, spinach, or peas for the fall.
