Project Checklist for February

- Keep an eye on your houseplants. Make sure they are getting enough water and humidity this time of year.
- Cut branches of flowering shrubs like forsythia, pussy willow, quince, and magnolia to bring inside and force blooms.
- Start slow starter seeds now for growing indoors.
- Prune branches that have been damaged by winter snows and storms (but leave maples and birch alone until they have leafed out).
- Plan a vegetable garden this year—its one of the best ways to go “green” this year. Providing fresh grown vegetables is healthy and economical!
- Hold on just a little bit longer, winter will end and the gardening season will start soon!
