## Project Checklist for June

- Monitor the amount of water your plants are getting from rain. If plants are wilting or getting brown leaves they will need to be watered by hand.
- Apply weed and feed fertilizer to your lawn.
- Divide and transplant perennials.

- Lightly trim spirea and other shrubs that have just flowered from the spring months.
- Monitor your planting beds for weeds and pull them as they come in. It is much easier to stay on top of the weeds if you start early rather than waiting too long.
