Project Checklist for May

- Cut back grasses to the ground to allow for new growth.
- Apply a top layer of mulch to your landscaping beds. As a general rule you should use about 1/3 to 1/2 of the amount it originally took to landscape your beds.
- Apply weed preventer products such as Preen to inhibit the growth of weeds in your beds. Organic Preen is also now on the market.
- Plant Spring Bulbs such as gladiolas, calla lilies, dahlias, calladiums and lilies.
- Apply Step 2 Fertilizer during the month of May. A good general rule is to apply Step 2 when the dandelions are up.
- Seed or over seed your lawn with grass seed. The spring temperatures and spring rains make it an ideal time to get your lawn looking great.
- Plant your vegetable seeds or plants after the frost free May 15th date.
- Plant your annuals after the frost free May 15th date to brighten up your yard with some splashes of color.
- Stake perennials that will grow tall in the summer now.
