## *Project Checklist for November*

- Keep your trees and shrubs watered until the ground is frozen.
- Finish clean-up on your landscaping beds, trimming back perennials and removing dead foliage.
- Cover exposed garden soil with a layer of shredded leaves for the winter.
- Wrap screening around fruit tree trunks that are commonly damaged by mice and voles. If deer are common in your area you might want to consider fencing trees to
- Plant bulbs until the ground freezes.
- Buy bulbs for winter forcing.
- Mulch rose bushes or put compost around them.
- Fertilize lawns one last time after it goes dormant.
- Check out the garden center for last minute deals—planting before the ground freezes.
- Enjoy a few last moments in the sunshine before the temperatures get colder for the year.
