

Plants for the Shade

It is important to note how much shade or sun an area gets before planting as there are varying amounts of light in any yard. Many plants will tolerate more shade or sun than is noted, they just may not bloom as aggressively or look as vigorous as they might if they were planted in the proper conditions. The list of plants below all work well when planted in part shade. Plants that also work well in full shade are noted with (FS).
