Project Checklist for September

- It's a great time to plant trees, shrubs, and perennials. Look for specials during the month of September.
- Plant some ornamental grasses to give winter interest to your beds.
- Divide perennials such as daylilies and hostas and transplant. Share or trade some with friends.
- Remove faded or burned out annuals in your planters and replace with cool weather annuals like mums, kale, grasses, and pansies.
- Harvest remaining vegetables in the garden and plant a fall spinach crop.
- Dig up bulbs such as gladiolias, callas, and cannas for storage over winter.
- Select and buy bulbs to plant this fall.
- Move houseplants indoors.
- Re-seed bare spots in your lawn and fertilize.
- Harvest herbs to dry and pot up tender herbs to bring inside.
- Continue watering all of your plants well.

Create a beautiful planter for Fall!

Fall is a great time to add some new found color to the yard. Create a planter like this by adding one 6" to 8" Mum, 1-2 types of Kale, one 6" annual purple grass, and 2 6" pots of . Pansies and Sedum also work well in fall pots as all of these annuals can tolerate cooler temperatures until it frosts.
